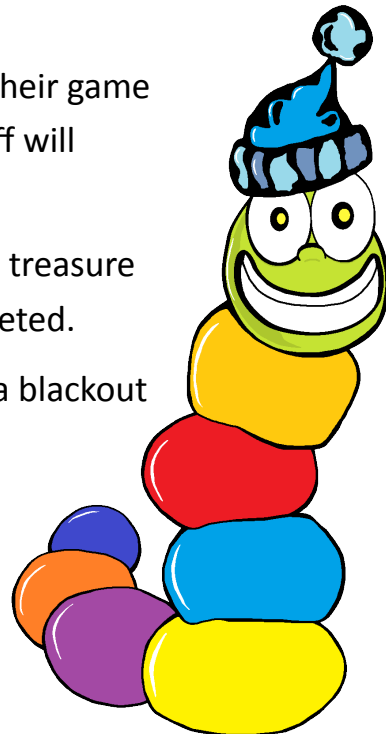


BOOKWARMS BINGO

BookWarms is our 2014-2015 winter reading program. It runs from December 29 to February 27. We have designed a BINGO card to encourage reading, learning, and exploring. Discover what the library has to offer this winter!

HOW IT WORKS:

- Complete the activity for each square.
- Complete four squares in a row to get a BINGO.
- For each BINGO, players bring their game board to the library. Library staff will stamp the completed squares.
- Players will get a prize from the treasure chest for the first BINGO completed.
- Players will get a free book for a blackout (all squares completed).
